Mary Wheeler, who we honor in granting these scholarships, was a teacher at Proviso High School from 1924 to 1965. She was a highly respected educator who was very actively involved in the American Federation of Teachers and the Illinois Federation of Teachers as an AFT vice president and an IFT president. She founded the Proviso Council of Teachers during the 1938-1939 school year and helped in the formation of several councils in the western suburbs. She was also president of the West Suburban Teachers Union, Local 571 for many years. Mary Wheeler represents, to the young people of this area, a very courageous, pioneering spirit in her profession.

Six (6), \$3,100, one-time scholarships will be awarded in 2022. Eligible applicants are high school seniors graduating in 2022 whose parents or guardians are members in good standing of Local 571. They must plan to continue their education full time in the Fall of 2022.

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
