<u>IFT (Illinois Federation of Teachers) Scholarships</u>—Applications for the 2022 scholarship awards will be available soon at <u>https://www.ift-aft.org/scholarships</u>

IFT Carl J. Megel Special Education Scholarship—One-time award in the amount of \$2,500. Megel award applicants may be sponsored by a parent or a teacher/counselor who is an active or retired IFT member. Applicants for this scholarship must be enrolled in a special education school, class, or program for students with autism, cognitive disability, deaf-blindness, deafness, emotional disability, hearing impairment, multiple disabilities, orthopedic impairment, other health impairment, specific learning disability, speech or language impairment, traumatic brain injury, or visual impairment.

The award is entirely unrestricted as to race, religion, political affiliation, or choice of accredited college, university, business, trade or vocational school. Applicant must be a high school senior who will graduate in 2022. The applicant must be the son or daughter of a currently employed, active member in good standing of the Illinois Federation of Teachers, or the son or daughter of a deceased member who was in good standing with the Illinois Federation of Teachers at the time of death. Alternately, applicant may be sponsored by an IFT member who is an education professional and works directly with (or previously worked with) the student. In that event, the IFT member must provide a letter stating his/her reasons for sponsoring the student, as well as his/her own name, address and local number. Note: not open to students who plan to teach in special education.

IFT Robert G. Porter Scholarship — Two \$10,000 awards (\$2,500 each year for four years) provided student is enrolled full-time at an Illinois public university and maintains a "C" cumulative average An applicant must be the child of a currently employed, active member of the IFT, the child of a member of an IFT retirees chapter, or of a deceased member in good standing with the IFT at the time of death. Applicants must be high school seniors with a cumulative "B" average. Winners must provide proof of acceptance and registration as a full-time student in a bachelor's degree program at a public Illinois university.

CFL (Chicago Federation of Labor)

William A. Lee Scholarship Program—Ten (10) \$2,000 one-time cash awards, five random drawing and five academic - open to high school seniors who will graduate in 2022 from Chicago-area high schools whose parents are union members in good standing. Those interested may apply for only one type of award and will be disqualified if they apply for both. In mid-December 2021, you may obtain the application at <u>https://chicagolabor.org/resources/scholarships</u>. Please be sure to indicate whether you want to participate in the academic competition or the random drawing. Note: On the application form, the Union Affiliation is the WSTU, Local 571, IFT/AFT. Application deadline is February 09, 2022 (tentative, please check website above).
